Meeting with Dr. WK Lo

ACEHK has conducted a breakfast meeting with Ir Dr Hon LO Wai-kwok, Member of the Legislative Council expressing the concern on recent filibustering in the Legislative Council Meeting which results in delay in the approval of financial funding for Public Works. Members also raised the issue that most of the consultancy services on railway projects have been completed or will be completed very soon. This is lack of upcoming railway projects to sustain the current workforce and some companies have released or demobilized their railway workforce.



Construction Industry Alliance - Say NO to Filibustering Parade for Livelihood

Filibustering is hurting our livelihood and the industry future. Further to the Construction Industry Alliance (CIA)'s Press Conference and the meeting with the Chairmen of Legislative Council (LegCo) Finance Committee and Public Works Subcommittee on 20 January 2016. The Alliance at its follow up meeting on 3 February 2016 considered that we should voice out and bring up public's awareness on the serious implications to the livelihood of construction employees and the local economy. At a time when the global economy is volatile the implication will be devastating.

Three rallies have been arranged on 13 March, 10 April and 8 May to express our grave concern on the impact of filibustering in the LegCo. ACEHK will continuously fight for the livelihood of construction employees and the local economy.





Belt and Road Portal

ACEHK was invited by HKTDC to become one of the advisors in the Belt and Road Portal. As an advisor, ACEHK will be listed in the portal. In return, ACEHK would agree to provide a one hour free consultation, on Belt and Road related infrastructure projects, to each enquirer. These consultation sessions will be carried out in person in Hong Kong. Should the enquirers require further consultation (i.e. after the first hour), individual advisors could consider charging a consultation fee at their discretion.

Belt and Road Summit 2016

The event is organised by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administration Region, supported by the People's Republic of China's Ministry of Foreign Affairs, National Development and Reform Commission, the Ministry of Commerce, and the People's Bank of China, in association with the Hong Kong Trade Development Council. More than 20 international thought-leaders, senior ministers from countries along the Belt and Road, and renowned business leaders will offer their insights during the conference.

Over 2,500 participants, including key figures of international institutions, corporate leaders, project owners, global investors and service professionals, are expected attend the event, providing networking opportunities.

China's Belt and Road Initiative is designed to enhance the orderly free-flow of trade and the efficient allocation of resources by expanding business cooperation between East and West, from Asia to Europe via Southeast Asia, South Asia, Central Asia, West Asia and the Middle East

The "Belt" and "Road" refer to the Silk Road Economic Belt and the 21st Century Maritime Silk Road, respectively. The Initiative offers companies unparalleled opportunities to tap new markets and explore the tremendous potential of the Chinese mainland, ASEAN countries and many other economies along the Belt and Road.

To highlight the excellence of Hong Kong's infrastructure and real estate-related services in the context of Belt and Road initiative, ACEHK is invited by HKTDC to join the event and is offered to have a display area to showcase how Hong Kong's Infrastructure and real estate-related sector can offer its service and bring about economic benefits to the markets concerned under the Belt and Road initiative.

The event has been held 18 May 2016 at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre. Significant projects from ACEHK member firms are displayed at the ACEHK booth. Leaflet introducing ACEHK is also placed at the display area provided by the HKTDC.



Construction Industry Security of Payment Ordinance

ACEHK has been invited to join the task force for preparation of legislative proposal to the Construction Industry Security of Payment Ordinance to provide advice on industry practices and operation details relevant to the proposal and to resolve issues referred by the Government for finalization of the legislative framework. 3-month Consultation for the proposed Ordinance has been conducted from 1 June 2015 to 31 August 2015 and regular meetings have been held to offer comments and advice on responses received and proposed amendments.

Consulting Engineering Committee (CEC)

ACEHK has continuous meetings with Development Bureau in the Consulting Engineering Committee (CEC). It is a forum for the discussion of all matters relating to the employment of engineering and associated consultants. Below are some of the topics under discussion:
